The next Senedd term (2026–30) must achieve Wales global commitment to protect and restore 30% of nature in Wales by 2030. Nature recovery is not only about wildlife. It is about people, communities, and our shared future.

Investing in **community-led, nature-based solutions** offers excellent value for money across government. Restoring natural habitats deliver multiple benefits: improving public health, strengthening food systems, increasing climate resilience, preventing floods, supporting education, building community cohesion, and boosting local economies.

Nature at the centre of Government

A future Welsh Government must fully integrate nature into all policy and decision-making, recognising that every sector can impact and benefit from nature.



Wales has world-leading environmental legislation and has signed up to ambitious international commitments. What is urgently needed is delivery backed by investment, coordination, and political will.

Nature's right to exist and flourish should be recognised along with every citizen's right to access nature.

Without action at scale and pace, nature will continue to decline across Wales. The next Senedd term must be the turning point for nature's recovery so future generations can benefit from a nature-rich Wales.




Creating space

Protect and effectively manage 30% of land, freshwater, and sea for nature by 2030 by delivering an expanded and well-resourced network of protected area to deliver benefits for both people and nature.

Enabling farmers

Deliver an ambitious Sustainable Farming Scheme that works for people, nature, and climate by providing a sufficient multi-year budget for action for nature on farms.



Strengthening planning

Adopt an ecosystem-based approach to infrastructure planning on land and at sea that stops development in designated sites and on irreplaceable habitats and prioritises nature-based solutions.

Increasing investment

Scale up investment by unlocking long-term public and private finance for nature recovery on land and at sea and ensuring every Welsh Government portfolio includes investment in nature-based solutions.



Stopping pollution

Deliver a coordinated, cross-sector approach to cut domestic and agricultural pesticide use by at least two-thirds by 2030. Strengthen monitoring, enforcement, and penalties for agriculture runoff and sewerage that is polluting our rivers.

Green prescribing

Recognise and invest in nature's ability to prevent illness and improve mental health by creating a Welsh 'Natural Health Service' approach through funding community-based health initiatives that support green and social prescribing.


